#### A. CHANGES TO SPECIFICATIONS:

The Table of Contents shall be updated as follows:

- Section 33 42 13 is to be renamed Section 33 42 36.

Delete Section 33 42 36. Clause 1.2.3

.3 The quantity of RACS that will be paid under "Lump Sum Price Item 4 - Fortitude" and "Lump Sum Price Item 5 – Park One & Fidelity" shall be the number of RACS transported to site, assembled, tested, commissioned and accepted by the Departmental Representative, and shall be inclusive of all costs of labour, materials, permits, licenses, manuals, documentation and equipment to satisfactorily complete this item as specified and in accordance with Section 33 42 35 – Special Procedures RACS.

Insert Section 33 42 36, Clause 1.2.3

.3 The quantity of RACS that will be paid under "Lump Sum Price Item 4 - Fortitude" and "Lump Sum Price Item 5 – Park One & Fidelity" shall be the number of RACS transported to site, assembled, tested, commissioned and accepted by the Departmental Representative, and shall be inclusive of all costs of labour, materials, permits, licenses, manuals, documentation and equipment to satisfactorily complete this item as specified and in accordance with Section 33 42 36 – Special Procedures RACS.

Based on this information, the performance criteria, and the Geotechnical Report, the Contractor shall provide the make and model, number, configuration, alignment and sizes of the proposed RACS at the time of bidding, subject to approval by the Departmental Representative. The following conditions will apply:

Insert Section 33 42 36, Clause 1.7.3.17

The Contractor shall not change the make and model of the proposed RACS, provided at the time of bidding, unless approved by the Departmental Representative.

Delete Section 33 42 36, Clause 1.9.13

The system shall not require, nor shall the Contractor construct, any infrastructure or facilities additional to those provided by PCA or outlined in this Contract. This does not include storage facilities for spare parts used for routine maintenance, construction of which will be incidental to the work.

Insert Section 33 42 36, Clause 1.9.13

The construction of any infrastructure or facilities additional to those provided by PCA or outlined in this Contract shall be incidental to the work. This includes explosive storage magazines and other storage facilities.


