QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS NO. 1

Q1 You refer to 17 cuts, from May to November, on the calendar. Do we start to count with a day highlighted in blue or white?

R1 : Start the first cut of the growing season within 2 days after the Parks Canada representative's request. Continue the work at the rate indicated on the calendar for the rest of the growing season. Please note that the days highlighted in blue and white indicate garbage collection days.

Q 2 According to the Statement of Work, must we pick up the cut grass or leave it on the ground?

R 2: Grass shavings must be removed in order to leave the site in an impeccable state.

Q 3 With three tractors, according to the work description, all of the cutting and maintenance must be done the same week. Approximately how many hours of work are estimated as being required to do the entire cut?

R 3: The work must be completed within the established 5 work days, i.e. from Monday to Friday, to the satisfaction of the Parks Canada representative. Because the site is busy, cuts must be made early in the morning. The Contractor is responsible for establishing the number of hours that will be required to complete the work.

Q4 : Will there be a recycling container on site?

A4 : No. The Contractor will be responsible for transporting the recycling material off the site themselves and disposing of it in an acceptable manner.
