QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS NO 2

1) How and to what extent must we prove that we have the experience required in the solicitation?

Answer: The contractor must demonstrate that his team possesses the necessary experience by providing verifiable sources (previous experience).

2) During Festibière, is it the contractor's responsibility to clean up the site that is dirtier than usual?

Answer: No, Festibière will be required to hire a company to clean up the site and leave it in its original state.

2.1) Is it the contractor's responsibility to empty the Parks Canada trash cans after Festibière?

Answer: Festibière is responsible for picking up the garbage inside the zone designated for the festival. The contractor will empty the trash cans in the rest of the site.

3) The basis of selection being the lowest price, does the price evaluated include the first three years only, or those three years plus the two option years?

Answer: The price evaluated will include all of the years, including the option years.

4) Must the equipment required for the lawn cutting and aeration remain on site during the entire length of the contract, or must it simply be in the contractor's possession?

4.1) If the equipment must remain on site, from our experience, these standards are quite exaggerated (especially the number of tractor and aerators on tractors). We believe that these requirements will simply require us to raise our price all the while reducing our efficiency in terms of time spent on site.

Answer: No, the equipment does not need to remain on site at all times.

4.2) Would a lawn tractor of type Z-Trak by John Deere be acceptable (for example, model Z900 R 60")?

Answer : Yes
