This amendment is being raised to provide clarification, make changes to the requirement and to respond to questions submitted in response to solicitation 5P420-15-5283/A:

A. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

- Q1. Are there long term environmental concerns with using explosive products in Federal Parks?
- A1. The impacts of any of the currently available industry standard avalanche control explosives have been reviewed as part of the Basic Impact Assessment related to this project, and have been determined to be acceptable for the expected life of the systems and project.
- Q2. Are there long term security concerns with using and storing explosives in Federal Parks?
- A2. None.
- Q3. Is there a designated staging area for helicopter operations, if so what is the proposed location?
- A3. Yes, the Fidelity Campground which is 100m off the TCH highway at km 40. Fidelity Campground will be closed for public use. Further to Section 01 11 00, Clause 1.12, the Contractor is reminded that other forces may use this area at the same time and therefore it is expected that the Contractor will cooperate and coordinate his work with that others. No delays claims will be entertained by Parks Canada Agency as a result of this coordination of work. Please refer to Section 01 11 00, Clause 1.6 for information regarding stations.
- Q4. Will it be possible to store one or more helicopters, fuel and support equipment/ supplies at a designated staging area at or near the Fidelity/Fortitude paths?
- A4. It will be possible to store fuel and support equipment/supplies at the Fidelity Campground, provided they are stored according to Section 01 35 43. It will not be possible to store one or more helicopters at Fidelity Campground.
- Q5. Is there a proposed laydown for materials receiving and storage, if so what is the size of the laydown and the proposed location?
- A5. Yes, a space approximately 50m long by 30m wide will be available at Fidelity Campground.
- Q6. How is the tender evaluated? Is it 100% price (assuming the minimum specifications are met), or is there an element of experience, and/or methodology included in the evaluation.
- A6. The compliant bid with the lowest evaluated price will be recommended for award of the contract.
- Q7. Will temporary structures be allowed in the park during the construction phase, such as emergency shelters and helipads?
- A7. Please refer to Section 01 14 00, Clause 1.5.3 for temporary structures. Emergency shelters and helipads will not be allowed.
- Q8. Will cutting of emergency access/egress trails be allowed in the park during the construction phase?
- A8. Please refer to Section 01 35.43.and Section 33 42 36, Clause 2.1.6.
- Q9. Is the requirement for there to be explosions at or directly above all target locations? Or can explosions be in the vicinity (50 to 100 m) of target sites assuming they can be reasonably proven to provide an effective blast to the target area?
- A9. Please refer to Section 33 42 36, Clause 1.9.4.
- Q10. There are eight different sites identified for RAC installations. How many duds are recorded landing in each of these sites? Could you please provide some mapping of where you would anticipate the duds landed?





A10. There are a number of unexploded ordnances in the area. A detailed list of these unexploded ordnances will be provided to the Contractor following Contract Award. The Contractor is responsible for performing a detailed ground survey according to Section 33 42 36, Clause 2.1.3 of the extents of their construction footprint.
