This amendment is to respond to questions submitted in response to solicitation 5P420-15-5275/A:

A. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

Q13. The tender requires that all materials for the snow nets are on site in March. This time line is extremely aggressive and perhaps not achievable by any producers. It is also unnecessary with regards to having material available for construction as there may be many months before all of it is needed as the anchors need to be drilled first. Is it possible to set up a schedule for material delivery agreed upon by Parks whereby, for example, a third of the snow net material arrives at the current date stipulated, another third a few weeks later and the last third a few more weeks?

A13. See amendment 003, B. Changes to Specifications for further details.

Q14. It was noticed that the number of rows under amendment 001 do not match up with the maps provided. There are more rows in the amendments, eg.:

- the maps show 13 rows for Cougar Corner #6, the amendment has 16 rows (plus an a and b for rows 4 and 11)
- the maps show 10 rows for Cougar Corner #7, the amendment has 13 rows (plus an a and b for rows 8 and 9)
- the maps show 9 rows for Cougar Corner #8, the amendment has 7 rows.

Are the maps posted the latest version?

Q15. Referring to this project, could you tell us what value we should use for the snow density? We require this information to do a proper design of the snow nets.

A15. Refer to amendment 002.

Q16. Can Contractor receive permission from Parks Canada to perform "maintenance" and "non-production" work at designated work/laydown sites on Sundays?

A16. Permission is granted for the Contractor to work on Sundays in the construction laydown area only. No work outside of the construction laydown area is permitted unless authorized by the Departmental Representative.
