The following questions were received:

Question 1

Are you able to provide RCMP Platform Specific Installation manuals?

Answer 1

There is a Type 1 installation manual which can be made available to bidders. Simply contact the Contracting Authority if you would like to be sent a copy. Bidders cannot distribute or copy the Manual and it must be returned with the bid package.

Question 2

All parts are supplied in this tender, correct?

Answer 2

The RCMP will provide the parts; however, the contractor is responsible for providing all consumables and shop supplies (i.e. nuts, bolts, screws, ty wrap, fuses, etc.).

Question 3

Can you confirm what is considered an access controlled area for storage?

Answer 3

The storage area must be secure and only be accessible by employees of the vendor who are security cleared to work on RCMP vehicles.

Question 4

Can you advise on page 43, what is meant by “unfurnished parts used in all RCMP installation and removals will be priced at contractor list price less a discount of _____ %”?

Answer 4

Unfurnished parts would be any wiring, nuts, bolts, fuses, relay switches, etc. needed to complete an install but not provided by the RCMP. All major components such as partitions, emergency lighting, consoles, decals, etc. will be supplied by the RCMP. The vendor will not be responsible to purchase any of this type of equipment on our behalf.

Question 5

Would you accept a quote for the parts as “cost-plus” rather than “retail-less”?

Answer 5

Unfurnished parts used in all RCMP installations and removals should be priced at the contractor’s list price less the contractor’s stated discount.

Question 6

Are these vehicles being picked up and dropped from RCMP locations within Moncton? Also, are the auction sites for drop-offs located in Moncton as well?

Answer 6

Units are responsible to get the old vehicles to and picking up the new vehicles from the installers’ facility. The auction company will arrange to have the vehicles picked up from the vendors’ location when ready for disposal. There may be the rare occasion for the vendor to bring a vehicle to the auction site, which is located in the Moncton area. “Jockey Service” mainly relates to the shuttling of vehicles between dealerships (i.e. for warranty work) or other third parties for installation (i.e. truck cap installation) and the contractor’s secure compound, on an as-needed basis.
