If no other supplier submits, on or before the closing date, a statement of capabilities meeting the requirements set out in the ACAN, a contract will be awarded to the pre-selected supplier.

Background

The Department of *Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada* has a requirement for as and when required support on the Departments FreeBalance Financial Accountability application software that is available exclusively through FreeBalance Inc. FreeBalance Custom Products, the Product Support and Maintenance (PSM) as well as professional services related to the system.

The work will involve the following:

- 3.1 Support with the resolution of problems;
- 3.2 Creation of scripts to manipulate data;
- 3.3 Data conversion and/or data migration;
- 3.4 Upgrade services;
- 3.5 Configuration and customization services;
- 3.6 Technical and functional training:
 - (a) The Contractor must provide training in the use of its Software on an "as-and-when-requested" basis during the Contract Period when a Task Authorization for training is issued in accordance with the Contract.
 - (b) Canada may issue a Task Authorization whenever it has at least THREE (3) people who require training. The training must be provided at 350 Albert Street, Ottawa, Ontario, as requested in the Task Authorization.
 - (c) The training must be available within 15 working days of the Task Authorization being issued.
 - (d) The training, including both the instruction and the course materials, must be provided in English.

The proposed contract is for a period of 13 months, from March 1, 2016 to March 31 2017. The contract will include the option to extend the contract for two (2) additional 12 month periods, if required.

The FreeBalance Financial Accountability application is proprietary software that is available exclusively through FreeBalance Inc. FreeBalance Custom Products, the Product Support and Maintenance (PSM) as well as professional services for FA is available exclusively through FreeBalance. FreeBalance Inc. is the developer of FA and the sole owner of the Intellectual Property. FreeBalance is the only authorized provider of FA Pro Services.

Based on NSERC's current internal level of knowledge and proprietary nature of the Freebalance application NSERC will contract directly with FreeBalance for professional services to implement any of the tasks related to their on-going requirements on an "as and when requested" basis while the application is still in use.

Justification for the Pre-Selected Supplier

FreeBalance Inc. has proprietary rights to the Freebalance Financial Accountability Application being used by NSERC for its departmental financial management system.

Suppliers who consider themselves fully qualified and available to meet the specified requirements may submit a statement of capabilities in writing to the Contracting Authority identified in this Notice on or before the closing date of this Notice. The statement of capabilities must clearly demonstrate how the supplier meets the advertised requirements.
