**Amendment 002**

Amendment 002 is raised to:

- 1) Provide answers to bidder questions.

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- 1) Answers to bidder questions.

Q1: The material testing is a lump sum unit on the bid form. As such it does not represent costs to be incurred dependent on whether the optional volume of hazardous waste is intended to be disposed. Is the intent to provide lump sum price for the testing of all 7830 metric tonnes of hazardous waste regardless of whether all waste is to be included into the contract?

A1: Yes, the lump sum price for testing should include all material, including both the Base Work and the Optional Work.

Q2: If waste amendment is not achieved on the basis of the 8% will the unit rate be applied for additional percentage of weight as required to achieve amendment criteria?

A2: If the Contaminated Waste Amendment is not achieved on the basis of 8%, as described in Specification 011100-1.1.7, then additional Amendments will be paid on the basis of a negotiated Change Order, using unit rates for additional amendments added and effort in additional amending. Note that while the Contractor is solely responsible for determining the Amendment, in order to consider a Change Order the onus is on the Contractor to demonstrate, to the Departmental Representative's satisfaction, that additional amendments are required. This may include the Contractor providing written documentation from a third-party consultant.

Q3. The Specifications 011100 1.11 states that all work must be completed by 2016Mar31. Does this include Optional Work?

A3: Yes. As per the Specifications 011100 1.12, there is no restriction in the days of week or the hours of the day that the Contractor may work on the Site. Also note that the Value of Project is estimated to be between \$2,000,000 and \$2,200,000. So although there is no obligation on the part of PWGSC to proceed with any portion of the Optional Work the current funding allocation for the Work (Base Work + Optional Work) is approximately \$2,200,000 (unless additional funds become available). The Contractor will be informed as to the amount of Optional Work, if any, at the time of the Preconstruction Meeting.
