Project: Institute of Ocean Sciences Parking Lot C & Asphalt Repair Areas 1 and 7.

*This Addendum is issued prior to close of Tenders and will form part of the Tender Documents. Please ensure that this addendum is noted in the Form of Tender and is included in the Tender Submission.*

The following items shall comprise the Addendum:

1. **Contact for Questions on Tender** – Ken Ngan from Public Works is the sole contact for any tender queries. Questions are to be directed in writing to Ken.Ngan@pwgsc-tpsgc.gc.ca
2. **Geotechnical Consultant** – The owner will retain a geotechnical engineering consultant for the project. This company is not yet determined.
3. **Unknown or Existing Underground Services** - The contractor is to conduct an independent investigation of the underground services within the work area to locate and identify all services before any work commences. The services shown on the plans are to be viewed as not complete and not accurate. Bidders are to assume there are existing services within the zone of excavation
4. **First Nation Observers** – The local First Nations will have a representative(s) on site during the work. In particular, we expect that they will be observing the excavating portion of the work. It is possible that they may find some material or objects in the excavations that are of archaeological significance and the First Nation may then ask the Institute of Ocean Sciences (IOS) to have the contractor stop work in a specific area. If this is to occur, then the IOS will negotiate with the contractor for delays or extra work under the terms of the contract.
5. **Pavement Lifts** – The heavy duty pavement thickness can be placed by the contractor in a single lift (rather than two lifts); provided the contractor can achieve the asphalt pavement specifications (including compaction, gradation, surface finish, grading tolerances, etc.)
6. **Test Holes** – Contractor to assume the test holes will be 1.0m deep.
7. **Arborist Supervision at Tree Roots** - The contractor is to hand dig (or hydro-vac) around any tree roots when working adjacent to trees. The owner will then have their arborist inspect the roots, and conduct pruning as necessary. They will determine if the tree will need removal to allow for a good pavement structure. The cost of the arborist's time is to be borne by the owner. The contractor is to give the arborist reasonable notice and arrange for the arborist to view the site during the hand digging or hydro-vacuuming. Any contractor time in this work shall be included within the bid prices.
8. **Layout of the Work** – Contractor is responsible for all layout of the work.
