26	Q&A 2 indicates the intent is to install in GC executive boardrooms. 1.2 a indicates the goal is to have 40% of public service employees enabled by March 2017 and 80% of public service employees enabled by March 2020. This seems in contradiction to the answer to Q&A2. Is Canada indicating that employees are considered enabled when the user is within, or in proximity to, the boardroom?	A2 did not intend to represent that the Wi-Fi service would be installed exclusively in GC executive boardrooms. GC users will be considered enabled when they are in proximity to wherever the Wi-Fi service is installed.
27	Q&A 3 indicated the GC employee can receive education online or in a class room environment through the CSPS. Can Canada confirm if this will be within the executive boardrooms or are additional areas at the school required to have coverage to allow this?	GC employees can receive training in a classroom setting or online from any location. Please also see Answer 26.
