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Amendment #3 of Solicitation 201605740 has been issued to respond to **Questions and Answers – Part 3**, and issue **Addendum #1**. The Addendum will be uploaded to Buy and Sell under “Attachments”.

**Questions and Answers – Part 3:**

Q4 – Under the Specifications; General Requirements for Rocky Mountain House, Section 23 05 9 pertaining to Testing, Adjusting and Balancing is a requirement; however this particular section is not referenced under Division 23 of the Specifications. Can you please confirm if balancing is to be included for Rocky Mountain House, as well as, High Prairie?

***A4 – Testing, Adjusting and Balancing is required for Rocky Mountain House but NOT required for High Prairie.***

Q5 – With respect to the Project Phasing approach, would it be safe to assume that we are required to complete the Construction of half of the cells to 100%, and then return to complete the construction of the other half of the cells to 100%, later?

***A5 – Yes, the first phase must be inspected and certified prior to the start of the second phase.***

Q6 – With respect to the Project Phasing approach, how are we expected to accommodate the RCMP using these cells over the course of Construction?

***A6 – The cells not being renovated during construction will be used by the RCMP. If the RCMP have to bring in an individual that passes by/through the construction area construction personel will be required to move all tools and personel from the area to allow safe transfer of the individual to a cell.***

Q7 – With respect to the Project Phasing approach, will there be additional security requirements to allow Construction to take place in the cell block with potentially occupied cells?

***A7 – Yes, see Addendum #1 for the inclusion of construction walls for High Prairie and Rocky Mountain House.***

Q8 – Under Drawings, E-2; note A, shows a one (1) inch conduit is to be concealed in all areas. Would this conduit be run in the attic space and then dropped down? What type of ceiling currently exists, and what is deemed concealed?

***A8 – Yes, the conduit is to be run from the attic space and dropped down or they can be run up from the crawl space in Rocky Mountain House and Chateh.***



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Q9 – With respect to mechanical items; are we to supply all fixtures for these projects (toilets, sinks, shower valves, grilles)? The drawings only indicate to install but not provide.

***A9 – All of the above items are to be supplied and installed by the Contractor.***

Q10 – Can you please clarify the security process for transferring prisoners to an from the Construction locations?

***A10 – Note that during construction the hallways must be kept clear at all times due to the need for transferring prisoners to the operating cells. All personnel working within the facility buildings will require a security clearance (level of clearance may vary). Clearance will take between 6 to 12 weeks to complete.***
