The following supplements and/or supersedes the request for supply arrangement documents issued on February 16, 2016. This addendum forms part of the contract documents and is to be read, interpreted, and coordinated with all other parts. Any change to the cost of the work as a result of this addendum is to be included in the price proposal. The following revisions supersede the information contained in the original Request for Supply Arrangement Package for the above-mentioned project to the extent referenced and shall become part thereof.

<u>Q & A</u>

- Q25. Canada is requesting that all the Building Assessments Reports (BAR) for international locations be completed in accordance with Canadian Codes and Standards. The common denominator for all international projects is ISO 9001 certification. R1 of Addendum #1 eliminated the points for ISO certification, while experience conducting BAR's in 3 or more foreign countries receives 5 additional points. Since the BAR's are required to meet Canadian Standards regardless of which countries they are located in, it seems more appropriate to award additional points for ISO certification rather than for work completed in foreign countries?
- A25. Quality Assurance evaluated at R1 shall not be confused with the international experience which is evaluated at R2. Although ISO certification will not be awarded additional points, it still may be taken into consideration when evaluating the R1 criteria.
