Amendment 006 is raised to answer questions asked during the site visit.

Q: Are 4-wheelers permitted on Cape Sable Island?

A: Yes. The use of these types of vehicles will be limited and subject to review and approval of Contractor's Environmental Protection Plan. Vehicle path must avoid the important bird area and site must be left in the same or better condition than current. Refer to the specifications including, but not limited to section 01 35 43 Environmental Procedures.

Q: Is PPE required in order to get scaffolding in place?

A: Yes. Refer to specification section 02 81 01 Hazardous Materials, subsection 1.5.2 Health and Safety.

Q: Will the photos shown at the site visit be made available?

A: Yes. See attached file named "Presentation Slides – Cape Sable Photos.pdf"

Q: How often will the structural engineer be on site throughout the project?

A: A representative from the prime consultant (Taylor Hazel Architects), and/or its structural sub-consultant, will be on site every 2 weeks, or on an as-needed basis depending on how the project is progressing.

Q: Once sand blasting is complete and outer finishes removed, who will give the approval to proceed?

A: The Departmental Representative is responsible for all approvals. The Departmental Representative will consult with and/or appoint a delegate (i.e. Consultant) in order to give approvals during the execution of the Work.

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Q: Is the Contractor responsible for providing washroom facilities?

A: Yes. Contractor must provide its own washroom facility for its workers.

Q: Can we land a helicopter on Cape Sable Island?

A: Helicopters will not be permitted to land on Cape Sable Island between May and September. Limited helicopter use may be possible during that period provided the following steps are taken to avoid impact on sensitive bird habitat: flight path must avoid the important bird area, materials are to be transferred via long line slinging only, and helicopters may only approach from Southwest of the site. Specific plans for helicopter use are to be included in and subject to review and approval of the Contractor's Environmental Protection Plan. Refer to the specifications including, but not limited to section 01 35 43 Environmental Procedures.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
