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## **SCOPE OF WORK / DELIVERABLES**

Work of this Contract comprises the installation of the Cathodic Protection System on the Warf at Paspébiac fishing Harbour in the Gaspesia region comprises, but is not limited to:

- Installation of temporary facilities required for this project;
- Preparations and installation of Cathodic Protection System equipment;
- Welding;
- Under water works; and
- General cleaning after work.

## **Expected Start and Completion Dates**

The services of the Contractor will be commencing upon award of the contract. The expected completion date of this project is **October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016**.

## **MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:**
