SECTION A: QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

	Question	Answer
Q56	The company that I work for is a multi-national organization with a Canadian incorporated subsidiary. If we submit a bid in the name of our Canadian subsidiary, can we use the experience and previous moves of our parent company when responding to the mandatory and rated evaluation requirements?	<p>No. All experience has to be that of the bidder itself. The Bidder must use its experience and previous moves and not that of a subcontractor or any of its affiliates, including parent companies, subsidiaries and the like.</p> <p>As described in section 2.1 of the RFP, section 04 of 2003 Standard Instructions - Goods or Services - Competitive Requirements (2015-07-03), the "Bidder" means the person or entity (or, in the case of a joint venture, the persons or entities) submitting a bid to perform a contract for goods, services or both.</p> <p>As described in 3.2 Section I: Technical Bid, (iv) of the RFP, "Previous Experience: Where the bid must include a description of previous relocation experience: (i) the experience must be the experience of the Bidder itself and cannot include the experience of any proposed subcontractor or any affiliate of the Bidder; ...".</p> <p>If a joint venture is used, the bidder must be aware of the joint venture requirements described in 2003 Standard Instructions - Goods or Services - Competitive Requirements (2015-07-03) and 3.1 (e) of Part 3 – Bid preparation Instructions and 2003.</p>
Q57	Based on the Canadian Content requirement referenced in section 5.1 (b) of the RFP, in order to be considered compliant does this mean that my bid has to be from a Canadian company?	No. In accordance with Standard Acquisition Clause and Condition (SACC) Manual clause A3050T, if an international firm can offer Canadian services, they are considered as offering Canadian content. The Canadian Content Certification requires that 80% of the individuals providing the services must be based in Canada.
