



## **ADDENDUM # 4**

*Solicitation Number: 16-1069*

*Title: 16-1069 B9 Walk-In Cooler Upgrade*

*Date: June 20, 2016*

The following supplements and/or supersedes the Invitation to Tender documents issued on May 31, 2016. This addendum forms part of the contract documents and is to be read, interpreted, and coordinated with all other parts. Any change to the cost of the work as a result of this addendum is to be included in the price proposal. The following revisions supersede the information contained in the original Invitation to Tender Package for the above-mentioned project to the extent referenced and shall become part thereof.

### **QUESTION AND ANSWER**

**Q4.** Bidder Question: *The previous addendum (# 2) does not clarify the issue sufficiently. In my interpretation, there is too much liability to the contractor without confirmation of the dimensions of the space to be conditioned.*

*In the original tender it specifically says “drawings not to be scaled” and that the contractor was required to field verify the accuracy of the dimensions. This made it quite clear that the drawings were not designed to be used for this purpose. If we are to quote now without dimensions, how can we be sure of the accuracy of the drawings? This places a lot of responsibility on the contractor without a reliable measurement for the insulated boxes.*

**A4.** The statement “drawings should not be scaled” means that bidders should only measure from drawings that were printed on a paper size that matches the size that the original drawings were created on – 33.11” x 23.39”, alternatively stated as 841mm x 594mm, alternatively stated as A1. The actual drawings are to scale as specified in the tender.

If bidders properly measure from correctly printed documents, bidders will be able to get accurate dimensions of the room and coolers.

For construction the contractor should field measure to verify before ordering the units.
