This amendment is raised to answer questions pertaining to solicitation H3551-150951 and to modify the solicitation as follows:

PART 1: QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

QUESTION 1. The RFP talks of two aircraft that are mandatory i) fixed wing capable of the missions and ii) a rotary wing aircraft. There is also a requirement for back up fixed wing aircraft.

Does the rotary wing aircraft have the same requirement as the primary fixed wing aircraft?

- a) Dedicated and available 24/7/365
- b) IFR and night operations
- c) medical interior and equipment
- d) long range to meet the requirement of service to the stated communities
- e) licensed for commuter by Transport Canada

ANSWER 1:

Yes, the rotary wing aircraft has the same requirements as the primary fixed wing aircraft. For question e) the bidder must have an Air Operator's Certificate in place at time of bid submission.

QUESTION 2: 1.6 Budget (pg. 8) states "Proposed monthly retainer and budgeted cost per flown mile projections". The "Description of Fee" on the rate sheet does not include a line for monthly retainer. Please provide guidance.

ANSWER 2: Please refer to amended Basis of Payment, in Part 2 of this document.

QUESTION 3: Provide additional clarity to "back-up fixed wing aircraft" and float/ski capability. Is the expectation that the back-up aircraft will be float/ski equipped?

ANSWER 3: Yes, the back-up aircraft must be float/ski equipped.

QUESTION 4: Does the primary fixed wing aircraft need to be a retractable geared aircraft or a float/ski equipped aircraft?

ANSWER 4: The primary fixed wing aircraft must be a retractable geared aircraft; and the back-up fixed wing aircraft must be float/ski equipped.

QUESTION 5: Would the backup fixed wing aircraft only be required when the primary aircraft be out of service for maintenance reasons?

ANSWER 5: The backup aircraft would be required to cover the dedicated medevac aircraft, at any time the dedicated medevac aircraft is unavailable. This is in order to provide to provide continuous medevac services without undue delay, 24/7, 365 days per year.

QUESTION 6: Are there any allotments for maintenance time throughout the year?

ANSWER 6: There would be no specific allotment of maintenance time. The Contractor would have to have another aircraft available (while the dedicated aircraft is under maintenance), that would be utilised with the required equipment and pharmaceuticals. As stated above the service requirements are continuous, 24/7, 365 days per year.

QUESTION 7: The estimated quantities in the pricing break down don't seem to make a lot of sense. A lot of these fees/charges could be included in a simple monthly retainer.

ANSWER 7: The variable rates would be effective when the aircraft is on a trip requested by the Provincial Aeromedical Coordination Centre. The monthly retainer would be to obtain a dedicated aircraft for medevac services.

QUESTION 8: Does medevac provider need to provide two dedicated medevac teams? One for fixed wing and one for rotary?

ANSWER 8: Yes, the Contractor must provide two dedicated Medevac teams. Two teams are required in the event that the primary fixed-wing aircraft and team are dispatched; and a second dispatch using the back-up fixed wing or rotary wing aircraft is required.

QUESTION 9: Several bullets end with asterisks *, what is the meaning of the asterisk? Is there a footnote attached?

ANSWER 9: The asterisks are irrelevant to this RFP. There are no footnotes associated with each * or asterisk. Please ignore.

QUESTION 10: Is the successful bidder responsible for transporting the patient from airport to airport, or do we include the cost for local ambulance services to bring the patient to the airport, and from the airport to the receiving health centre?

ANSWER 10: The tender doesn't include road ambulance fees. PACC, the Provincial Air Coordination Centre will call the local dispatching service and arrange the local road ambulance service to transport the patient to a facility.

PART 2: MODIFICATIONS TO THE RFP
