Q6: Are some sources of data directly integrated with the front-end Drupal site?

A6: The Drupal front-end contains a database that i) maps general community names to those census subdivisions in the Web Data Server (WDS) portion of the application, and ii) contains an indicator/theme hierarchy that is used to determine which map to display from the front-end mapping wizard. This database is built from the source data contained in the WDS and mapping portions of the site, however the Drupal database is independent from the other source data.
