

21. Is the intended outcome of the desktop study to develop the inspection plan?

Yes. The intention of the desktop study is to develop the inspection plan per pasture/ company with the following considerations:

- Identify density/complexity of lease locations
- Recognize historical site issues (as per Project manager's recommendation)
- Identify unique/site specific challenges. E.g. topography; distance to pastures

22. In the event of non-compliance, will be provide a description or evidence of the non-compliance?

Letters of non-compliance will be supplemented with inspection reports and pictures.

23. The RFP states that the draft report must identify equipment used during the inspection. Are the inspections visual or are you expecting intrusive investigations? (ie. soil salinity measurements)

Intrusive investigations will not be necessary. Should the contractor feel the need for a more concrete identification of concerns in isolated cases, they can be discussed with the Project Manager.

24. Can you clarify the invoicing procedure? Is the completion of the surface lease inspection form considered a deliverable with which we could invoice monthly for the inspections we have completed or only at delivery of the reports?
