AMENDMENT 003

This amendment is being raised to respond to questions and to correct a specification reference under solicitation 5P420-16-5131/A:

A. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q9. What does Type 1 or Type 2 – Transplanted Conifers really mean?

A9. Parks Canada has requested that nursery stock is not used, as it will not be adapted to local environmental conditions. The intent is to use locally adapted, transplanted plant material. Source of material should be based on local cultivars. The contractor is encouraged to transplant material that will otherwise be cleared and grubbed during construction of the parking lot. If this is not possible, alternate sources of transplant will be considered from within Jasper National Park (if regulatory requirements allow), or from a nearby location outside of Jasper National Park, as approved by Departmental Representative.

Refer to specification Section 32 93 10. A relevant excerpt is provided below.

.1 Collected stock: maximum 40 mm in caliper, with well-developed crowns and characteristically branched; no more than 40% of overall height may be free of branches.

Q10. What does Type 1, Type 2, etc. – Transplanted Shrubs really mean?

A10. Source of material should be based on local cultivars. The contractor is encouraged to transplant material that will otherwise be cleared and grubbed during construction of the parking lot. If this is not possible, alternate sources of transplant will be considered from within Jasper National Park (if regulatory requirements allow), or from a nearby location outside of Jasper National Park.

For sizes, refer to the planting plan.
