Part 1. INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 Elections Canada hereby amends in accordance with this amendment the Request for Standing Offer (RFSO) for Language Training Services bearing number ECCL-RFSO-16-0007 and dated July 13, 2016 (the "RFSO"). This amendment hereby forms part of the RFSO.
- 1.2 Unless defined herein or unless the context otherwise requires, all of the words and phrases defined in the RFSO and used in this amendment shall have the same meanings assigned to them in the RFSO.

Part 2. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following question(s) have been asked in response to the Request for Standing Offer and Elections Canada hereby answers as follows:

2.1 Question 12 – (Amendment to Question 9)

<u>Question:</u> It states that the Offeror may propose a maximum of four primary teaching resources and two backup teaching resources. The rated criteria are by teaching resource and are a maximum of 25 points for the resource criteria. Do we get more points if we propose more resources? How will you decide between two Offerors if one proposes two resources and the other the maximum four resources?

Answer: (This is an amendment to question 9)

No extra points will be granted for extra resources proposed.

If the Offeror is proposing more than one Primary and/or Back up Teaching Resource, each of the Primary and/or Back up Teaching Resource will be evaluated, and the sum of the points obtained will be divided by the number of Primary and/or Back up Teaching Resources.

2.2 **Question 13**

Question: What is the proportion of French Training vs English Training?

Answer: On average 70% French Training vs 30% English Training.

2.3 **Question 14**

<u>Question:</u> How many learners per year will be requiring Part-Time Individual Language training services in French and in English and how will the level of language competency be divided?

<u>Answer</u>: Language training services is a new initiative for Elections Canada. Classes will be held based on Elections Canada's needs. Therefore, the number of learners and the language competency division per year cannot be determined.

2.4 **Question 15**

<u>Question:</u> Could you please let us know what the estimated yearly amount is for the RFSO?

<u>Answer</u>: Language training services is a new initiative for Elections Canada. Classes will be held according to Elections Canada's needs. Therefore, the volume cannot be determined. No budget cap has been defined for this need. (Refer to Question 8)

2.5 **Question 16**

<u>Question:</u> For M3 and M5: for Annex B to Part 7 Form -do we need to fill out this form for each individual the instructor has taught over a course of year (up to the 1,060 hours each year) to prove that instructor has met the mandatory requirements? Also to reach the maximum number of points we would then need to provide over 9 years of client names for each instructor.

We ask, as most instructors do not work with 1 client to reach 1,060 hours in one year, in fact most have multiple learners over the course of the year and to prove the hours, a lot of paper work would be required to illustrate the instructor hours to prove they reach over 9,540 hours of instruction.

We would ask, that you consider on their CV a yearly break down of total hours taught along with Annex B form filled out for 3 clients for each instructor to illustrate they have met the requirements as requested.

<u>Answer:</u> The Teaching Engagement / Client Reference template must include the number of teaching hours accumulated for each Teaching Resource per client.

I.E.: Multiple dates will be accepted on each Teaching Engagement / Client Reference template per client.

PART 7—Technical Evaluation Criteria (Revised August 4, 2016)

SECTION A—INSTRUCTIONS TO OFFERORS

The following information and instructions relate to the submission and evaluation of the mandatory and point-rated resource evaluation criteria contained in this solicitation.

- 1. Offerors must only respond to the evaluation criteria for the category (French service category and/or English service category) for which they are submitting an offer. Offerors may submit an offer for one category or both categories under separate cover.
- 2. The Offeror may propose multiple resources as part of one offer (maximum of four (4) Primary Teaching Resources and maximum of two (2) Backup Teaching Resources).
- 3. A Primary Teaching Resource cannot be proposed as a Backup Teaching Resource and vice versa.
- 4. If the Offeror is proposing more than one Primary and/or Back up Teaching Resource, each of the Primary and/or Back up Teaching Resource will be evaluated, and the sum of the points obtained will be divided by the number of Primary and/or Back up Teaching Resources.
- 5. In order to facilitate the evaluation of the offer, EC requests that Offerors address and present topics in the same order and with the same headings as the evaluation criteria. Offerors should clearly identify where in their offer each criterion is addressed.
- 6. Any education/certification/professional qualification must have been completed by the offer closing date.
- 7. Cutting and pasting wording from the RFSO into the tables for the proposed resource does not constitute demonstrating the requirement. Experience must be demonstrated by citing specific examples of work performed by the proposed resource that relate to the specific evaluation criteria. If the Offeror's Response does not fully demonstrate that the requirement is met by the project cited, then the project experience will not be considered.
- 8. A minimum of 1,060 hours of teaching English and/or French as a second language to adult learners is required to equal one year of experience.
- 9. Unless otherwise specified in the individual criterion, demonstrated experience must have been completed in the last seven years of the offer closing date.
- 10. In addition to the information requested in the individual criterion, the Offeror is requested to include complete client contact information for each experience description including the client contact name, title, telephone number and email address. The client contact for any project or experience must be an employee of the originating client organization. EC reserves the right to request client contact information, at any time during the evaluation process, for the purposes of verification.

11. Proposed resources that do not meet all of the mandatory evaluation criteria or do not attain the thresholds for the point-rated criteria will be given no further consideration.

SECTION B—DEFINITIONS

Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the capitalized terms used in the Technical Evaluation Criteria shall have the definitions assigned to them in the offer. These definitions shall apply equally to both the singular and plural forms of the terms defined, and words of any gender shall include each other gender when appropriate.
