**ADDENDUM #1**  
**Eco-Science Building Recapitalization**  
**Terra Nova National Park, NL**  
**Issued August 23, 2016**

The following shall be added to the plans and specification to form the complete tender documents for the above noted project:

***GENERAL***

1. Terra Nova National Park is home to the Little Brown Myotis and Northern Myotis, which are a species of bats classified as Endangered under the Species at Risk Act. The Contractor is to note that if they encounter bats in the facility during demolition activities, the following is required:
  1. Immediately notify the Departmental Representative for directives to be followed.
  2. Stop demolition activities and do not disturb the roost.
  3. Do not initiate demolition activities until the bat vacates the premises. The expected time frame for a male bat to vacate the premises would be in the order of 1-3 days. In the event a maternity roost is discovered (females with pups), the expected time frame for the bats to vacate the premises would be in the order of 1-3 weeks.
  4. Departmental Representative will make final decision regarding shut-down times and work return times, as it relates to the discovery of bats in the facility. Note that there will be no additional cost to Canada for downtime associated with the discovery of endangered bats in the facility and the subsequent no-work periods established by the Departmental Representative.
