Q.1 If an alternative method of accessing the area of work was proposed would that be approved before the closing date? Our company utilizes Rope Access for many projects. I have experience in previous lead abatement projects for Fisheries and Oceans where getting scaffolding to the required area was half the cost of the project. The work area around the lighthouse would still be contained with tarps and protected from the elements. If we could propose a preliminary proposal to gain approval to bid the project this way, we would consider bidding the project.



A.1 The Specification states that the tower exterior is to be scaffolded and hoarded. This is necessary to ensure proper temperature and surface conditions at this location in late September. The use of a rope system would not provide this protection. There is also the concern regarding the anchoring system- the rope system would need to anchor itself to the catwalk and/or dome. Given the age and condition of this structure we do not think this is a feasible approach.

All other Terms and Conditions for this requirement remain unchanged.
