SCOPE OF WORK / DELIVERABLES:

The scope of work consists of the furnishing of all plant, labour, equipment and material for this telecommunication mast lighting system replacement work on multiple-sites, QC. The project is to be completed in strict accordance with the specification and accompanying drawings, and subject to all terms and conditions of the Contract.

In general, work under this contract consists of, but will not necessary be limited to, the following:

1. Dismantling cables, junction boxes, existing beacon lights to replace, and other system components that are no longer required, including off-site transportation of all materials and equipment;
2. Supply and installation of the new LED lighting system including cables, junction boxes, beacon lights, control panels and other equipment required for the proper functioning of the system.
3. When required, make the necessary trenches needed to install cables and restore the soil in a good condition;
4. When required, supply and install a in order to protect the beacon lights.

Please note: If required, snow removal costs between the road and the mast will be done by the contractor and included in the submission.

FAMILIARIZATION WITH SITE:

Before submitting a bid, bidders can visit the site and its surroundings, at their own expense, to review and verify the form, nature, and extent of the work, materials needed for the completion of the work, the means of access to the site, severity, exposure, and uncertainty of weather, soil conditions, any accommodations they may require, and in general shall obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies, and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. No allowance shall be made subsequently in this connection on account or error or negligence to properly observe and determine the conditions that will apply.
