This amendment is raised to respond to bidder questions and to extend the solicitation closing date until September 15, 2016.

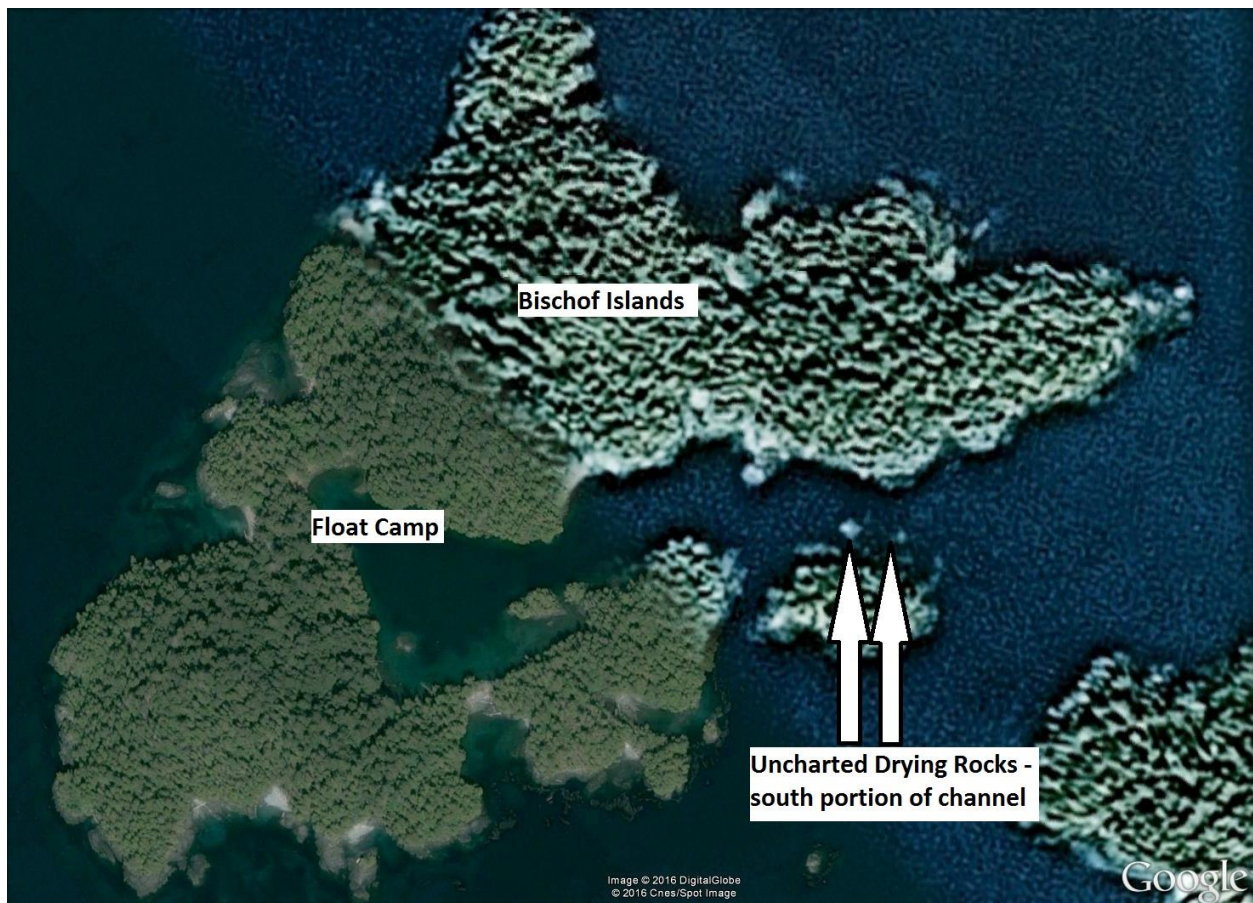
The closing date for tender 5P420-16-5127/A, titled "Barge Services to Support Helicopter Operations for Ecological Restoration in Gwaii Haanas, BC", is extended from September 13, 2016 until September 15, 2016.

1. Question

Can you please provide bathymetric information of the water depth and any hazards such as rocks and drying banks for Bischoff Island Cove?

Answer:

The Bidders are referred to the most current digital navigational charts for the area with one exception. The two (2) large rocks just east of the entry point to the cove are mapped incorrectly and are on the south side of the channel rather than the north. The narrowest point to allow entry into the cove was measured at low tide and was approximately 120ft. across. The cove has no hazards of rocks or drying banks. Parks Canada Agency will provide consultation with the Gwaii Haanas captain or engineer to the successful Bidder to ensure all navigational hazards are known.

2. Question

Who will be accessing the barge while in Bischoff Cove? Assuming that access will be required by boat, will ladders attached to the hull be sufficient for this access?

Answer:

The project crew as well as the helicopter crew will be accessing the barge. Ladders will be sufficient.

3. Question

Will the project crew be able to monitor and maintain the barge once the Contractor delivers it into Parks Canada's custody and control? This will include checking for water ingress, confirming anchor stability, and possibly operating the anchor winches if moorage needs adjustment?

Answer:

Yes.

4. Question

Article 6.10 under Part 6 – Resulting Contract Clauses of the Request for Quotation mentions certificates but no specifics. What certificates are required to accompany the bid submission?

Answer:

See Part 5 – Certifications and Additional Information.

5. Question

In addition to dropping anchors, we would like to consider using securing cables to shore to prevent possible anchor movement due to tide and current forces. Does Parks Canada have any concerns from if Bidders were to explore this option?

Answer:

Securing ropes are permissible and will need to be removed when the barge is taken away. No damage can result from the use of the securing ropes.
