QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1 - Does the rail have to be adjusted vertically?

A1 - The expectation is that the rail be adjusted vertically were reasonable using plant otherwise contemplated to complete the remaining tasks identified herein.

Q2 - Can the rail be adjusted horizontally without moving the ties/sleepers?

A2 - It is expected that the rails can be aligned without adjustment to the underlying supporting infrastructure (ties and sleepers)

Q3 - Are there any restrictions on placement of silt curtain regarding boat movement at the base?

A3 - The eastern face of the wharf is to be maintained clear of obstruction unless otherwise approved in writing by Project Authority



Q4 - Can the holes for cross tie rods (26) be burned or do they have to be drilled?

A4 - Diameter of holes must not exceed tolerance as stipulated in CAN CSA S-16. Holes are to be of uniform and consistent diameter. Holes will need to be drilled or burned and rheemed.

Q5 - Can you provide more information on the existing "Tower" that is to be removed.

A5 - Section 024116 Demolition of Structures, Item 3.4.1 indicating "Salvage the existing tower complete with all lighting equipment and related appurtenances" is to be stricken or otherwise omitted from requirements.

All other Terms and Conditions for this requirement remain unchanged.
