QUESTIONS and ANSWERS

1. Question from Bidder:

Is it possible to host our team directly on the site of Heath Point in the shelter provided for this purpose?

DFO Answer 01:

No.

2. Question from Bidder:

For electrical work, we use local electricians for each site and will be a member of the Corporation of Master Electricians, is this okay?

DFO Answer 02:

The work must be done under the supervision and responsibility of a single contractor with qualifications and experience to ensure quality work and be a member of the Corporation of Master Electricians of Québec (CMEQ) or equivalent in another Canadian province.

The project manager in the field must have at least five (5) years of experience in the telecommunications tower erection and / or five (5) years of experience in the installation of electrical equipment on telecommunications towers including working at height, allowing it to be critical and independent in its work. Provide the curriculum vitae of the project manager in the field after the award of the contract.

3. Question from Bidder:

Could you confirm the amount of lights to be installed at Heath Point site?

4. Question from Bidder:
