A. AMENDMENT TO THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) :

Section 4B Specific Mandate of the Consultant, clause 3.1.1 General, paragraph i. Location **ADD** the following:

The Consultant will receive a 12-month advance notice if the relocation is approved. Any relocation-related costs will be considered reimbursable expenses requiring DFATD's prior approval.

B. Questions & Answers

Question	On page 51 of the RFP, DFATD notes that there may be a relocation of the current Canadian High Commission office in La Paz, and that the successful bidder will be required to move the FSS office space to continue to comply with proximity requirements. Should bidders pre-emptively include office relocation in their planned expenses, or will this be reimbursed by DFATD on an as-needed basis during project implementation?
