This amendment 003 is issued to respond to questions from the industry and revise certain clauses in the RFP document as described below.

Part A – Question and Answers

1) Question 002:

Could we please have a one week extension to the bid submission date?

Response to Question 002:

At this time Canada is not in a position to extend the solicitation closing date.

2) Question 003:

Is it possible to get Annexes and appendices in Word format?

Response to Question 003:

The only available formats are posted on the Tender Notice page on the [Buyandsell.gc.ca](https://buyandsell.gc.ca) web site. No other formats will be provided.

3) Question 004:

For the technical bid submission (as per Part 3.3 Volume I: Part A - Technical Bid requirements), are respondents required to provide substantiation for all 110 items outlined in Section 5.4.1 Mandatory Solution Based Requirements?

Response to Question 004:

Bidders are required to complete and sign the Certificate of Compliance, Attachment 5.3 of the RFP to certify that its proposed **SOLUTION** will satisfy the requirements of Annex A to Part 7 - Resulting Contract Clauses in accordance with Article 3.3 (c) (ii) to Part 3 of the RFP.

4) Question 005:

- Is the video presentation meant to be a static video provided with the RFP response? If so, what is the preferred file format and length of video?
- Or is the video meant to be a demo presentation of the solution by short listed bidders that will follow a set agenda with specific timeframes? If this demo approach is anticipated, is there a target date for the presentations to occur or will the vendors be given a specific amount of time to prepare the demo?

Response to Question 005:

The preferred file format, length of the video, and whether it be a static video is left at the discretion of the bidder.

The video presentation is not meant to be a demo presentation of the solution by short listed bidders that will follow a set agenda with specific timeframes.

Part B – Revisions to RFP Document

1) At Part 3 of the RFP document, delete Article 3.3 (c) (ii) and insert the following:

(ii) Substantiation of Technical Compliance:

Bidders are requested to complete and to include the Substantiation of Technical Compliance Form – Attachment 3.2 with their bids.

The bidder must substantiate how they will meet the mandatory and rated requirements that are subject to the evaluation criteria against which the bid will be evaluated at Attachment 4.1. Simply repeating the statement contained in the RFP or stating that the Bidder or its proposed **SOLUTION** or product complies is not sufficient. Where Canada determines that the substantiation is not complete, the Bidder will be declared non-responsive and disqualified.

The substantiation may refer to additional documentation submitted with the bid - this information can be referenced in the "Reference" column of the Substantiation of Technical Compliance Form – Attachment 3.2, where bidders are requested to indicate where in the bid the reference material can be found, including the title of the document, and the page and paragraph numbers; where the reference is not sufficiently precise, Canada may request that the Bidder direct Canada to the appropriate location in the documentation.

The Bidder must complete and sign the Certificate of Compliancy – Attachment 5.3 to Part 5 to certify that its proposed **SOLUTION** will satisfy the requirements of Annex A to Part 7 - Resulting Contract Clauses.

2) At Part 5 – Certifications and Additional Information, Article 5.2 of the RFP document, insert the following:

(d) **Certification of Compliance**

The Bidder must submit to the Contracting Authority a signed Attachment 5.3 – Certification of Compliance, at bid submission.

All remaining terms and conditions remain the same.
