Amendment 001 has been raised, to provide answers to questions that were raised

- Question 1) Can you please confirm if all listed delivery locations have a dock for receiving?**
- Question 2) P.O. Boxes are not valid ship to addresses. Please provide the street name and numbers for the delivery locations.**
- Question 3) I noticed that there were no UPS listed on this inquiry, do you have another RFP posted for these?**
- Question 4) Is there a way to have these delivered to a central location as oppose to shipping individually to remote areas?**
- Question 5) Can you extend the solicitation closing date to October 17, 2016?**
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Answer 1) The RCMP Detachment locations identified under Annex C do not have loading docks or commercial receiving units. The RCMP will take care of shipping/delivery to the Detachment, once the equipment has been delivered to the community and they are notified of its receipt.

Answer 2) The RCMP Detachments are located in communities who do not have Standard Street names. PO Boxes and Business / Location names will have to suffice.

These are Fly-In Isolated Arctic communities that may have only a few hundred people within the community. The only commercial shipping methods for these communities is through Commercial Air Cargo, Canada Post or Sea Cargo (which this last option is no longer viable due to the time of the year). Shipping locations will have to remain with the PO boxes should Canada Post be utilized, which may not be a likely option.

Further to that, the delivery locations can only be noted as the Detachment Name (i.e. Arctic Bay RCMP Detachment). Any Air Carrier shipments will be relayed to the local Detachment Commander within the present community infrastructure, to arrange for local delivery and/or pickup.

Answer 3) The UPS have already been previously ordered under RCMP Purchase Order 7210569, issued to CDW Canada in the amount of \$ 20,705.24, on February 10, 2016.

Answer 4) The RCMP specifically requires each individual item to be delivered into the community and to the RCMP Detachment location as identified.

Answer 5) The solicitation closing date is not able to be extended, due to the need for the immediate delivery of the first four racks and subsequent delivery of the remaining racks by November 30, 2016, as identified in this solicitation under Article 6.4.1 – Delivery Date.
