The following supplements and/or supersedes the request for proposals documents issued on September 26, 2016. This addendum forms part of the contract documents and is to be read, interpreted, and coordinated with all other parts. Any change to the cost of the work as a result of this addendum is to be included in the Price Proposal. The following revisions supersede the information contained in the original Request for Proposals Package for the above-mentioned project to the extent referenced and shall become part thereof.

5. RFP; A8. Site Visit/Proponent Conference – is amended as follows:

**ADD:** “Proponents must be prepared to travel within two (2) weeks of Phase 1 closing date. In order to enter Senegal, the Proponent must have a copy of their yellow fever vaccine certificate and a valid passport/entry visa. Holders of a Canadian Passport do not require a visa to enter Senegal. Proponents are responsible for making sure they have all up to date vaccines and travel visa’s prior to the Phase 1 closing date.”

6. **Question #4:**

We are assuming that given the common requirement for similar projects that we may use the project cited for 2.1.1 as one of the five required under 2.2.1. Can you confirm?

**Answer:**

Yes, a project cited for article 2.1.1 may also be cited under article 2.2.1.
