QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- Q1) Annex A asks for cost per site (division) but I don't see what is the quantity of battery required per site (division)
- A1) We are asking you to provide your unit price per division.
- Q2) Do you require installation services per site? If so is it during normal business hours?
- A2) No installation required.
- Q3) Do you have a minimum warranty request from the moment the battery is shipped?
- A3) Please review the warranty provision under SACC manual clause 2010A (as referenced at Part 6B. Resulting Contract Clauses)
- Q4) What does it mean the risk mitigation of exchange rate: SACC Manual C3011T (2013-11-06) Exchange Rate Fluctuation? Will the price of the battery fluctuate according to the exchange rate?
- A5) As indicated at Part 2 section 2.1, all clauses identified in the Request for Standing Offer are set out in the Standard Acquisition Clauses and Conditions Manual (<https://buyandsell.gc.ca/policy-and-guidelines/standard-acquisition-clauses-and-conditions-manual>)
- Q5) Do all your sites have a loading dock to receive the delivery of these batteries?
- A5) Yes.
- Q6) Mandatory Requirement 2.8 states that the battery must have a hard plastic carry handle on both sides. Will you consider a battery with a different strap such as a 1" wide nylon strap?
- A6) No. The nylon strap is not acceptable. The wide plastic handles are required when RCMP Technicians. Carry several batteries into remote radio sites. A hard handle on both ends makes carrying the batteries easier for the Technicians.
