QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question 6

Please confirm that the “duly completed certifications” required for Part 5 only involve declaration statements(s) that we are in conformance with all the provisions of the Ineligibility and Suspension Policy, and declaration statements that satisfy SACC Clauses S3005T and S1010T.

Answer 6

A declaration statement is sufficient at the time of bid closing for SACC clauses S3005T and S1010T.

Article 01 Integrity provisions—arrangement in 2008 Standard Instructions - Request for Supply Arrangements - Goods or Services (2016-04-04) details the submission requirement(s) for the Ineligibility and Suspension Policy. Please see below for a summary of the requirements.

5.1.1 Integrity Provisions - Declaration of Convicted Offences

An [Integrity declaration form](http://www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/ci-if/declaration-eng.html) (<http://www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/ci-if/declaration-eng.html>) must be submitted **only** when

1. You, one of your affiliates or a proposed first-tier subcontractor has been charged with or convicted of a criminal offence in a country other than Canada and to the best of your knowledge and belief, the offence may be similar to one of the listed offences in the Ineligibility and Suspension Policy
2. You are unable to provide any of the certifications required by the [integrity provisions](https://buyandsell.gc.ca/policy-and-guidelines/policy-notifications/PN-107R2) (<https://buyandsell.gc.ca/policy-and-guidelines/policy-notifications/PN-107R2>)

5.2.1 Integrity Provisions – Required Documentation

Section 17 of the [Ineligibility and Suspension Policy](#) (the Policy) requires suppliers, regardless of their status under the Policy, to submit a list of names with their bid or offer. The list differs depending on the bidder or offeror’s organizational structure:

- Suppliers including those bidding as joint ventures, whether incorporated or not, must provide a complete list of the names of all current directors.
- Privately owned corporations must provide a list of the owners’ names.
- Suppliers bidding as sole proprietors, including sole proprietors bidding as joint ventures, whether incorporated or not, must provide a complete list of the names of all owners.
- Suppliers that are a partnership do not need to provide a list of names.

Question 7

Please confirm that the supplier DOS and personnel Reliability Status are not required at the time of the SA submission, but must be obtained prior to any bid solicitations against the SA.

Answer 7

A Designated Organization Screening (DOS) is not required in order to be issued an SA. Suppliers that do not have a DOS may request a sponsorship from PWGSC to initiate the procedures for security clearance.

At RFSA 1.3 Security Requirements

DELETE:

Suppliers are informed that there is a possibility that some solicitations against the Supply Arrangement might require that the supplier hold a valid Designated Organization Screening (DOS) issued by the Canadian Industrial Security Directorate (CISD) of Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC) and that their personnel requiring access to sensitive work site(s) must hold a valid Reliability Status, granted or approved by CISD/PWGSC.

Should the successful suppliers not have the level of security indicated above, PWGSC shall sponsor the successful suppliers so CISD can initiate procedures for security clearance. CISD, by letter, shall forward documentation to the successful suppliers for completion.

Suppliers desiring such sponsorship should so indicate in their covering letter with their proposal.

Successful supplier(s) issued a Supply Arrangement as a result of this RFSA, not possessing the required security clearance at time of a solicitation, will be bypassed in the selection process as detailed in Part 6B. For all bid solicitations against this supply arrangement (Part 6C) it will be mandatory to meet the security requirements at the time of bid closing.

INSERT:

Suppliers are informed that there is a possibility that some solicitations against the Supply Arrangement might require that the supplier hold a valid Designated Organization Screening (DOS) issued by the Canadian Industrial Security Directorate (CISD) of Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC) and that their personnel requiring access to sensitive work site(s) must hold a valid Reliability Status, granted or approved by CISD/PWGSC.

Should the successful suppliers not have the level of security indicated above, PWGSC shall sponsor the successful suppliers so CISD can initiate procedures for security clearance. CISD, by letter, shall forward documentation to the successful suppliers for completion.

Suppliers desiring such sponsorship should so indicate in their covering letter with their proposal.

Most solicitations issued against the Supply Arrangement will not contain security provisions. However, if a solicitation issued against this Supply Arrangement does contain a security requirement, suppliers that do not have the necessary clearance at the time of the solicitation selection process detailed in Part 6B will be bypassed. In these scenarios, compliance with the security provisions would be mandatory at the time the SA issued RFP closes. Solicitations that contain a security requirement higher than a DOS will be not be solicited using this SA.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
