Description of Work:

The Department of Justice (JUS) is implementing an Information@Justice vision that articulates a future desired state that “Justice Information lives in a sustainable digital environment” in contrast to past practices that have been structured around paper content. One of the keystone projects to implement this vision is a Digital Workspace (DW) for the department, whereby employees will have an electronic workspace that supports creating, sharing, and finding digital content and collaborate on this content with their colleagues.

JUS has an estimated 103 terabytes of information resources on Exchange servers and shared drives. Currently, there are over 107 million objects that reside on shared drives. Manual document and metadata migration is an arduous, taxing and inefficient process, not to mention an inefficient use of staff resources and productivity. Without a solution to migrate documents, it is unreasonable and impractical to expect that the JUS employees will continue to migrate documents on their own. This will severely impact the success of the DW initiative.

The scope of the project is limited to:

- Data on 16 JUS Departmental servers (~100TB)
 - ~80TB on 12 File Shares servers (~107 000 000 files)
 - ~20TB on 4 Exchange servers (total number of emails not available)
