## AMENDMENT 006

This amendment is being raised to respond to questions submitted in response to solicitation 5P420-16-5241/A:

### A. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- Q26. Is the monitoring wells and water hand pump to be decommissioned to AB Environment Standards by a certified driller?
- A26. The Hand pump (B.I. 1.4) has been taken out of the contract, see revised Price Table. Any monitoring well (B.I. 1.5) must be decommissioned in accordance with the current Province of Alberta Environment Standard by a certified driller.
- Q27. Can you please let me know the volume of the effluent tanks under the existing toilets and how full they are?
- A27. The volume of each tank is 1500 us Gallons. The tanks were emptied to roughly 50% when the campground was closed. The rest can only be accessed when the building is removed. The contractor will be responsible to clean out the tanks prior to their removal.
- Q28. Will the campground be open in the 2018 season? If it will be open, how will pedestrian traffic on seeded and planted areas be controlled? Grass and plantings will not survive pedestrian traffic. Maintenance will also be very difficult if the campground is open during maintenance.
- A28. Silverhorn Campground is scheduled to be open in the 2018 season. Signage and fencing can be used to control pedestrian traffic. Signage and fencing if needed will be the responsibility of the contractor.
- Q29. The unit price schedule includes 5 months of maintenance. The documents state that project completion is July 21, 2017, and the maintenance period ends September 30, 2018. If we are providing maintenance from the start of April to September in 2018 as stated in the specs, that is 6 months. August and September of 2017 will also require maintenance.
- A29. The contractor is responsible for providing the cost for 5 months of maintenance as shown in the unit price schedule. The maintenance has to occur within the dates provided in the specification.
- Q30. Can you confirm that there is only one Toilet Building with two stalls for the Bid Item 9.1, rather than two separate buildings, as it seems on the Schedule of Quantities? Section 03 45 00, 1.2.2 calls for a complete toilet building complete with everything including toilets, urinal.... From the drawings, I only see one toilet building with two stalls, divided by an interior concrete wall.
- A30. The Contractor is responsible to provide two (2) complete toilet buildings as stated in the Unit Price Table (B.I. 9.1). The two (2) toilet buildings are to be placed in the same location (side by side) as shown on the drawings. To your second question please refer to Section 03 45 00, 1.2.2, as well shown on page L-30, L-31 from 909 Silverhorn Campground - Construction Drawings.
- Q31. Drawing L-27, Detail 4, Firepit. Can you explain what the purpose of the "Rolled Plate Steel Front 470 x 140 x 6mm" and comment if it is wanted on the new firepits?
- A31. The current design and specification shown on drawing L-27 are correct.
- Q32. Section 32 92 19 states that bark chip mulch is to be mixed with seed mixture. Please confirm that this is a mistake and that hydromulch is to be used.
- A32. Section 32 92 19, 3.4.2 should state Hydromulch.
- Q33. Could you please explain the rationale behind the roof structures for the 2 concrete washroom units spec'd for the above project. The reason for my inquiry is because we do have a few generalists contact us for some of those units, however our system comes with a precast roof system which could be stained to match the exact look of



the metal roof structure (please see attached photos for an assembled and unstained unit/s that we're currently building for a number of AB Parks projects. Please note we have other available textures) of our existing designs which we would seek to submit as an alternate and or if an amendment could be considered to allow for a concrete roof.

A33. Toilet buildings are to be constructed as shown on the drawing and described in the specification package.
