

CLARIFICATIONS:

We are hoping you might answer the following questions before we put an order into MERX.

1. If there is an eventual tender call would one have to have submitted an expression of interest to be “eligible” to submit a bid? **NO you will not have had to submit an E of I to be able to bid.**
2. We are not familiar with the term Hogen building - kindly provide a brief description of same. **[KnisterR] HOGEN refers to the building which will house a Hydrogen Generating unit.**
3. Is there such a thing as a 20 foot high shipping container? Perhaps we misunderstood and it is two (2) 10 foot high containers stacked one on the other. **[KnisterR] Refer to the drawings attached to the EOI write up. It is actually supposed to read 20 foot long, high cube containers (9'-6" tall). They would be placed next to each other on a screw jack foundation.**
4. Previously owned or new shipping containers? Would we be allowed to fabricate a reasonable facsimile of same on our own? **[KnisterR] currently we are assuming new containers, previously owned containers would need to be reviewed and accepted (must be in perfect like new condition to even be entertained). Currently we are proposing new containers, fabricating may be a viable option.**

In regards to the Expression of Interest for the HOGEN buildings. I'm assuming the future bids would be not only for the buildings but for the functioning generators inside too? Would the equipment and mechanical design be provided or is that part of what the future bidding would entail? **[KnisterR] The functioning generator is an owner supplied item. Mechanical design would be complete before tender. Equipment would be specified prior to tender.**
