This Amendment 002 to the Solicitation is raised to address Bidder inquiries and to attach insurance requirements at Annex C.

QUESTION 1a:

Drawing CMTK201

- This appears to be a welded assembly with no insulation. However, the hatch and Instrument door are insulated. Is that correct?

ANSWER 1a:

The assembly is joined in a composite method using some welded joints, through-bolted panels and captive PEM style nuts and some blind rivets.

All joints must be watertight using weld, sealant bedded joint or rubber seal/gasket.

The entire assembly is insulated using 2" thick polystyrene foam board insulation cut into specific shapes. (refer to attached Overview assembly drawing MTK204C)

QUESTION 1b:

The components are listed on page 2 in the bill of material, however there are no detail drawings for these. Are these drawings available?

ANSWER 1b:

QUESTION 2:

Drawing CMTK202 and CMTK203

- The components are listed on page 2 in the bill of material, however there are no detail drawings for these. Are these drawings available?

- Hardware items have part numbers, but no manufacturer/ Supplier name. Can this information be provided?

ANSWER 2:

Yes, See attached Overview assembly drawing MTK204C. In general, off the shelf parts are from several suppliers including McMaster-Carr and Sierra Pacific, generic SAE hardware is specified as 316 stainless steel.

QUESTION 3:

Are drawings available in SolidWorks, or is there another path or link where we can access more detailed information?

ANSWER 3:

Files will be available in .dxf and .step or .iges formats after contract award.

UNDER ANNEX "C" – INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS;

INSERT THE FOLLOWING CLAUSES:

Commercial General Liability Insurance


1. The Contractor must obtain Commercial General Liability Insurance, and maintain it in force throughout the duration of the Contract, in an amount usual for a contract of this nature, but for not less than \$2,000,000 per accident or occurrence and in the annual aggregate.

2. The Commercial General Liability policy must include the following:
 - a. Additional Insured: Canada is added as an additional insured, but only with respect to liability arising out of the Contractor's performance of the Contract. The interest of Canada should read as follows: Canada, as represented by Public Works and Government Services Canada.
 - b. Bodily Injury and Property Damage to third parties arising out of the operations of the Contractor.
 - c. Products and Completed Operations: Coverage for bodily injury or property damage arising out of goods or products manufactured, sold, handled, or distributed by the Contractor and/or arising out of operations that have been completed by the Contractor.
 - d. Personal Injury: While not limited to, the coverage must include Violation of Privacy, Libel and Slander, False Arrest, Detention or Imprisonment and Defamation of Character.
 - e. Cross Liability/Separation of Insureds: Without increasing the limit of liability, the policy must protect all insured parties to the full extent of coverage provided. Further, the policy must apply to each Insured in the same manner and to the same extent as if a separate policy had been issued to each.
 - f. Blanket Contractual Liability: The policy must, on a blanket basis or by specific reference to the Contract, extend to assumed liabilities with respect to contractual provisions.
 - g. Employees and, if applicable, Volunteers must be included as Additional Insured.
 - h. Employers' Liability (or confirmation that all employees are covered by Worker's compensation (WSIB) or similar program)
 - i. Broad Form Property Damage including Completed Operations: Expands the Property Damage coverage to include certain losses that would otherwise be excluded by the standard care, custody or control exclusion found in a standard policy.
 - j. Notice of Cancellation: The Insurer will endeavour to provide the Contracting Authority thirty (30) days written notice of policy cancellation.
 - k. If the policy is written on a claims-made basis, coverage must be in place for a period of at least 12 months after the completion or termination of the Contract.
 - l. Owners' or Contractors' Protective Liability: Covers the damages that the Contractor becomes legally obligated to pay arising out of the operations of a subcontractor.
 - m. Non-Owned Automobile Liability - Coverage for suits against the Contractor resulting from the use of hired or non-owned vehicles.
 - q. Sudden and Accidental Pollution Liability (minimum 120 hours): To protect the Contractor for liabilities arising from damages caused by accidental pollution incidents.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS REMAIN UNCHANGED.
