Question #2

Please clarify and confirm the draft and final due dates for the C-TEST-001 deliverable (RFP Appendix AB page 11 of 23, CDRL # C-TEST-001). Under Section 16 (Remark), it is stated that the final version of the VMSR is due prior to the draft version:

16.1 The DRAFT submission of the Verification Matrix Summary Report (VMSR) is due 90 days after contract award. The DRAFT is subject to review and approval by DND.

16.2 The FINAL copy must be delivered with the agreed changes 70 days after contract award.

Response #2

The table at page 8 of Appendix AB details correctly the due dates for the DRAFT and FINAL submissions for CDRL C-TEST-001. An error was made in Sections 16.1 and 16.2 on page 11 of the CDRL C-TEST-001. Here is the correction to Section 16.1 and 16.2 on page 11 of the CDRL C-TEST-001:

16.1 The DRAFT submission of the Verification Matrix Summary Report (VMSR) is due 90 days prior to the Factory Acceptance Test (FAT). The DRAFT is subject to review and approval by DND.

16.2 The FINAL copy must be delivered with the agreed changes 70 days prior to FAT.

Question #3

Reference Annex E – Bid Compliance and Evaluation Matrix requirement 1.1.2 for both Cold Lake (Part 2 of 4) and optional Bagotville (Part 4 of 4). It is stated that:

Circuits. The Contractor must ensure that the exact number and type of circuit is configurable and depend upon site requirements. The number and type of audio interface modules must also be configurable. The VCS must be capable of integrating/interfacing with the following at each of the six (6) console positions [four (4) console positions at Bagotville] at each site:

- a. Eight (8) [five (5) at Bagotville] PABX circuits connected to a Public Switched Telephone Network (PSTN);
- b. Four (4) "Ring Down" and two 4 Wire E&M analog circuits;
- c. Canadian Switched Network (CSN);
- d. Access to a minimum of thirty-six (36) G/A/G Radios [twenty eight (28) at Bogotville] (4 Wire E&M); which includes expansion positions;
- e. Tactical Satellite communications data/voice relay to North Bay; and
- f. Satellite Voice Radios (C2, time critical targeting, combat SAR).

Are the interface types and quantities required to connect to the CSN (item c), Tactical SATCOM (item e) and Satellite Voice Radios (item f) of the PABX, 4 ringdown, two 4-wire E&M and 36 4-wire E&M [28 at Bagotville] requirements? If not, please provide the required interface type and quantities to connect to the CSN, Tactical SATCOM and satellite Voice Radios.

Response #3.

The circuits mentioned are currently selectable on the existing Voice switch. The path should be from the console control touch screen to the new Voice switch then to the demarcation Bix; there should be no need for any other interfaces. The CSN is a 4 wire E&M loop-start circuit with all required interfaces at the Main Base PABX. The new Voice Switch is only the path from the console to the Main Base PABX.

Radios are routed to a microwave system.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE RFP REMAIN UNCHANGED.
