4. Offeror Questions and Answers

Q1. In reference to Part 1, paragraph 1.2 Summary, you have listed Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, North West Territories, Nunavut and Yukon as having shown interest in making call-ups against the Standing Offer, does this mean that all federal labs in Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, Newfoundland, Ontario, Quebec and Saskatchewan are "opting out"?

A1. All Federal government departments, agencies, and Crown corporations are using this standing offer.

The second paragraph of 1.2 Summary states "Canada has a requirement to establish a National Master Standing Offer (NMSO) for the supply of Laboratory Supplies on an "as and when" required basis to Federal Identified Users and to Provincial/Territorial Identified Users."

The third paragraph of 1.2 Summary lists the Provinces and Territories who would like to use this standing offer.

Please refer to the Key Terms at Annex F to find you will find definitions for who is included as a Federal Identified User and a Provincial/Territorial Identified User.

Q2. How will Authorized Users purchase brands which are not offered by the five (5) companies who will be attributed an NMSO?

A2. This will not be a mandatory standing offer for Laboratory Supplies. If there is a requirement for items not listed in the standing offer product offering, the buyer may purchase those items through other methods such as Local Purchase Order or a competitive solicitation, if applicable. If there is an ongoing requirement for certain products Authorized Users may request to add items to the standing offer every 6

months. *(Please refer to Part 6, paragraph 6.28.2, Product Additions – Original Products for more information.)*

Q3. Is it possible for a company that does not supply many Original Products to be one of the five (5) companies that will be awarded an NMSO?

A3. The ability to be one of the five (5) successful Offers is wholly dependent on the number and quality of the Offers received.

Q4. The Offeror Contact Information Template asks us to list our contacts for all of the provinces and territories, is this correct?

A4. You only need to identify provincial and territorial contacts for Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Northwest Territories, Nunavut, and Yukon. A revised template is attached, filename: OCIT v2.xlsx.

Q5. Is this procurement instrument intended to replace the current standing offers for laboratory supplies?

A5. Yes, however, the Chemicals category will be solicited separately.

Q6. Due to the upcoming holidays, vendor shows, and the complexity of this solicitation we would like to request that the solicitation closing date be extended.

A6. We are extending the closing date of the standing offer until February 07, 2017.

Q7. Please provide us with 4 to 5 examples of each scenario in 6.19.

A7. We are not providing examples for each scenario in the Call-up Procedures detailed in the request for standing offer at Part 6A, paragraph 6.19. If the wording is unclear and you have a specific question regarding the Call-up procedures, please submit it in writing no later than 15 days prior to the closing date of this solicitation.
