Question and Answer number 1, 2, 3 & 4

Question #1

Is there AC power required? If yes, who is responsible? If contractor is responsible, provide the rout and specs.

Answer #1: AC power is required for tower lighting. The contractor is responsible for routing the cables through the building's crawlspace and basement in order to reach the junction box.

Question #2

Who will be providing the cables? The Coast Guard or the contractor?

Answer #2: The contractor is to provide all cables.

Question #3

Are there any tower and civil drawings? If so please provide.

Answer #3: Tower and civil drawings are not available.

Question #4

At Appendix 3, there is no antennas load chart. Please provide the list of antennas and their elevations
