Amendment 02

This amendment is being raised to distribute answers to bidder questions from site visit on December 22, 2016.

Q1 Shelter Demolition: Does the concrete get removed?

A1 No, concrete remains in place.

Q2 General: Can Ottertail pit be used during this project.

A2 No.

Q3 General: Is there any owner supplied material.

A3 No, all material is to be supplied/installed by the contractor.

Q4 Shelter Demolition: Does the Stove get removed/disposed?

A4 The stove is to be disconnected from the chimney, and removed from the shelter to an adjacent campsite prior to shelter demolition. Parks Canada will pick the stove up for use in another area.

Q5 Shelter Demo: Other than the cedar shingles, is there any roofing material underneath those shingles?

A5 This information is not available.

Q6 General: Are demolition permits required for this project?

A6 No. A restricted activity permit will be required for the work, Parks Canada will issue this permit prior to the start of construction. A building permit will also be provided by Parks Canada.

Q7 Shelter Demolition: What happens to the electrical line that connects to the shelter?

A7 Contractor is to cut the electrical conduit/cable 500mm above grade. Existing light fixtures (2) within the shelter are to be removed and returned to Parks Canada prior to shelter demolition. Power is currently disconnected from this shelter.

Q8 Shelter Demolition: Does the lower section of the shelter contain lead paint?

A8 Refer to the analytical sample results attached in the tender documents.

Q9 General: Where is snow removal required?

A9 Contractor is responsible for snow removal on Yoho Valley Road east of the entrance to the Monarch Campground. Contractor must maintain a 2.5m strip of snow on the south side of the road in order to facilitate track-setting equipment for cross country skiing. Contractor is also responsible for any snow removal required for laydown areas or access to the site within the Kicking Horse Campground. There are speed bumps installed between Yoho Valley road and the entry Kiosk to KHCG on both the entry/exit lanes, contractor is to locate and protect these speed bumps prior to snow clearing.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
