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## **AMENDMENT # 001**

- 1) Respond to the questions from bidders relating to the content of the RFP, as set out in Appendix 001;
- 2) Amend the Request for Proposal (RFP), as set out in Appendix 002;

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## **Appendix 001**

### **Question 1**

M6.

The crown states "The solution must have the ability to ingest vulnerability scan results from other vendors in either various formats." The crown does not elaborate or provide further definition in regards to this specific management function core to the Enterprise VMS solution.

The narrative of the "en\_annex\_a\_SOW" in both the Background (3.) and Objectives (4.1.) speak in detail to the need for an enterprise level solution, and for the crown to leverage existing VMS assets to augment existing capacity and capabilities. To accomplish this, the VMS solution must manage all 3rd party scan data being collected and ingested with equal functionality as it relates to: creating reports from scans, performing complex multi-departmental security analysis of data and maintaining an asset database.

Could the crown please confirm the aforementioned aligns with the desired outcome of this RFP and elaborate on (M6) mandatory management capabilities to ensure that adequate solutions are proposed to the crown?

### **Answer 1**

Yes the above aligns with the desired outcome of this RFP. We are looking for one tool that will allow us to cover the whole of SSC's infrastructure, both from a new infrastructure environment perspective while bridging in the many legacy environments that we still maintain.

The point of M6 was to allow for the enterprise solution to be able to ingest VA scan results from the other currently in place vendors until a uniform environment can be achieved.

The Crown will need to cohabitate multiple vulnerability scanning solution during the transition period, we are envisioning that this solution will provide the Crown with the ability to utilize it as a "centralized solution" as per the aforementioned concept of operation in the SOW, mainly for a centralized reporting service. This will require the high level requirement as defined in M6. No further technical detail will be provided for M6.

## **Question 2**

M21.

The Crown states “The solution must have Common Criteria certification at EAL3 or higher to ensure product has been adequately tested and reviewed.”

Can the crown please clarify this requirement? Due to the specificity of the EAL certification process our Industry research indicates that only one vendor in the “VMS” space currently complies with a version of its software dating back to 2012. No other currently leading vendors in the VMS space are certified to this standard.

## **Answer 2**

The requirement will be removed from the Mandatory Criteria and added to the Rated Criteria, please see Appendix 002
