

Q: Will CANADA accept other reputable furniture installers than Spurell's Cabinetry?
A: The furniture being installed matches with the ship's furniture retrofits that have been ongoing over the past 5-6 years and has already been cut, pre-fabbed and purchased. CCG can accept other furniture installers but the contractor would be responsible for any additional materials required to complete the installation. The spec calls for installation only, not materials.

RE: H-20
Q: Will the crown give an allowance to be used by all bidders to keep a level playing field? (yes or no?)
A: Yes, an allowance of A 15K has been given.

RE: E-12
Q: Will the CANADA give an allowance for the EP HVAC Technician to be used by all bidders to keep a level playing field? (yes or no?) And if so, please state allowance to use?
A: yes. 10 K given for travel

RE: Limitation of Liability clause included with tender document.
Q: Will CANADA accept proposal incorporating a limitation of liability clause into the Contract with the limit of \$10M? (Yes or No)
A: No. The Clause will not change for this refit.

RE: Part 7 of the tender document
Q: Will Canada waive the requirement to provide copies of insurance policies in lieu of certificates?? (Yes or No)
A: Yes, Certificates will do

RE: Hazardous Waste clause included in the tender document
Q: Will Canada allow us to follow standard marine practice and deal with the abatement and disposal of these substances as an extra to the contract if required? (Yes or No)
A: Yes, Hazardous material not identified or referenced within the specification will be dealt with as an extra.

RE: Ref spec item E-07 Fuel Oil, Lube Oil, and waste Tank Cleaning and Inspection
Para 2.1 indicates Qty 6 tanks.
Also in para 2.1 the capacities are different for qty 4 tanks than shown on the Capacity plan drawing.
Para 3.1.2 is indicating that there are Qty 9 tanks.

Q: Will Canada please clarify/confirm quantities and capacities of Fuel Oil, Lube Oil, and waste Tanks
A: Para 2.1 indicates Qty 6 tanks. **correct**
Also in para 2.1 the capacities are different for qty 4 tanks than shown on the Capacity plan drawing. **#8 port and stbd should be 32.8 m3 each and #10 port and stbd should be 39.1 m3 each.**
Para 3.1.2 is indicating that there are Qty 9 tanks. **Should read 6 tanks**

RE: HD-08

Q: Can you please confirm that the Amercoat coatings are a suitable substitute for the Wasser paint for ballast tanks on the Grenfell?

A: The temperature application is of 20 F or -7 C is comparable, but there is a dew point restriction on the Amercoat 240, unlike the Wasser Moisture cured Urethane which has no dew point restriction. The yard must include the cost associated with maintaining the dew point to the manufacturers recommended values for Amercoat 240 as part of their bid price should they decide to use this product. If so, substitution is accepted by CG.

RE: E-16

Q: How much oil and what type are we providing?

A: Tow winch oil -The hydraulic oil is now Hydrex AW-68 and the capacity is 400 liters.
