The bidders should indicate the number of hours in one working day.
 - The professional fees must include the total estimated cost of all travel and living expenses that may need to be incurred for:
 - Work described in Part 6, Resulting Contract of the bid solicitation required to be performed within the Ontario Region.
 - (ii) travel between the successful bidder's place of business and the <u>Ontario</u> Region. to satisfy the terms of any resulting contract. These expenses cannot be charged directly and separately from the professional fees to any contract that may result from the bid solicitation.
- (b) Applicable Taxes: The bidders should indicate the Applicable Taxes separately.
