Amendment 003 has been raised to answer the following questions:

- Q6. The ServiLocker units will interface to the host "Prescription" management system so all Rx's being dispensed by the ServiLocker are tracked. There are already several interfaces for the system in place in Canada (for example, Telus/Emergis, Kroll and ClickRx) so it would be important to know what dispensing software the Canadian military uses in its dispensaries. If the interface already exists, the implementation will be very quick, but if not, then development would need to be initiated. This is not difficult to do as typically an interface is developed for each new Rx system using existing API interface protocols. What Rx host system does the Canadian military use?
- A6. The Canadian military currently use Telus- Assyst-Rx-S (used to be called Simplicity Plus) within our pharmacies.
- Q7. What security protocols need to be in place for IT with respect to access? Autopharma can work with a wide range of approaches for updates and software maintenance, but the most recent approach which is popular with larger organisations is using a "Cloud Solution". For example, with the "Cloud Solution" the externally hosted solution would allow for instant program updates to all ServiLockers simultaneously within the dispensaries, or remote locations. Alternatively, individual servers at each site can be used, but this requires individual servicing, updating and software repairs, which is a slower and more involved process. Does the Canadian Military have a "Security Protocol" policy that they could share with Autopharma?
- A7. The dispensing machine would be installed on a regular internet connection. Thus allowing the vendor to connect to and perform required maintenance, as well as providing the pharmacy staff with access to the web portal or software program provided with the dispensing machine. With this approach, there would be no personal information sent; only the patient information and that an "item" was delivered. An "item" would have some type of tracking number that, when matched with the dispensing software, would identify the product. With this option there would be no direct interface between the pharmacy software and the dispensing machine.
