This amendment is issued to provide the following technical questions and answers.

Q1. In the areas with multiple cities listed (eg. 6.1, 6.2), please confirm that if services are expected to be offered in all cities listed, is there a minimum number of service offices expected within each service area?

A1. It is anticipated that a vocational rehabilitation consultant would be based in the subregion/area being bid on or close by and would be able to commute to that area with ease. Hence, if bidding on an area it is anticipated that there is an office in that one area. It is not anticipated that multiple service offices be in one area.

Q2. On page 40, the Evaluation Form asks for the Bidder to "provide top five (5) proposed staff only". If we are bidding on multiple areas, please confirm we are to list 5 staff per area?

A2. Yes, please provide 5 staff per area being bid on.

Q3. Does a supervisor or manager role count in the 5 staff to be listed or does the 5 count for VRCs only? If the Supervisor/Manager is not included in the 5 count, do you wish for us to include the resume of the Supervisor/Manager in addition to the 5 staff for informational purposes?

A3. The Supervisor/Manager is not included in the 5 staff providing Vocational Rehabilitation services to the CPPD clients. However, if the individual will be reviewing files we require their resume and security clearance. Clearly indicate that this individual is acting in a supervisory role and will not be providing direct services to clients.

Q4. Can you provide an estimate of the number of clients that each area could receive? We understand that client numbers are not guaranteed.

A4. As indicated the client numbers are not guaranteed as the CPPD Vocational Rehabilitation program is voluntary in nature. However, looking at Vocational Rehabilitation expenditures for the past 5 years the average expenditures to service providers per province are: Newfoundland: 97K; Nova Scotia: 160K; New Brunswick: 39K; Manitoba: 189K; Alberta (data last 3 years): 108K and British Columbia: 358K.

Q5. Please provide a description/explanation for assessment for intellectual testing? Is this intended to diagnosis an intellectual disability? Please advise if there is a specific purpose for the intelligence testing.

A5. Intelligence testing usually provides some form of a single global measure of a client's general level of cognitive development, such as an IQ score. Some tests also provide scores on sub-tests of various components of intelligence. The assessment of a client's general level of intelligence is useful in many different situations, such as the following:

- To identify the client's intellectual level as an aid in vocational assessment, job placement, training and / or education.**
- To obtain an objective means to help increase the self-awareness of a client who has an unrealistic view of their intelligence.**
- To evaluate potential success of a client in a particular course of action such as re-training or a new occupation for which a certain level of intelligence usually is required.**
- To identify; clients who are most likely to succeed in a particular occupation or educational opportunity as part of a selection process.**

Q6. Please provide a description/explanation of the requirements for work samples and job modifications.

A6. Work Sample:

Refers to the emulation of an actual industrial task, business operation or a component of an occupational area used by an evaluator to determine the individuals work aptitudes and abilities to function within a related vocational area while providing the client with direct feedback relative to his / her performance in these areas. Work samples also refer to a well defined work activity involving tasks, materials, and tools which are identical or similar to those in an actual job or cluster of jobs. It is used to assess an individual's vocational aptitude, worker characteristics and vocational interests. Examples of work samples are; Singer Evaluation System, Wide Range Employability Sample Test and Valpar Component System.

Job Modification:

Job-site, employer supported accommodations, intended to eliminate potential physical or emotional workplace re-entry barriers, in order to support the client's return to active, substantially gainful employment. This could include the implementation of appropriate assistive devices, job coaching, ergonomic adjustments etc.
