

## 2.3 Enquiries - Bid Solicitation

All enquiries must be submitted in writing to the Contracting Authority no later than five (5) calendar days before the bid closing date. Enquiries received after that time may not be answered.

Bidders should reference as accurately as possible the numbered item of the bid solicitation to which the enquiry relates. Care should be taken by bidders to explain each question in sufficient detail in order to enable Canada to provide an accurate answer. Technical enquiries that are of a proprietary nature must be clearly marked "proprietary" at each relevant item. Items identified as "proprietary" will be treated as such except where Canada determines that the enquiry is not of a proprietary nature. Canada may edit the question(s) or may request that the Bidder do so, so that the proprietary nature of the question(s) is eliminated, and the enquiry can be answered to all bidders. ## 1. **OBJECTIVE**:

1.1. The RCMP requires a contract to purchase, install, integrate, commission and provide training for an Eventide NexLog 740 Logger for the G Division Operations Control Center. This Statement of Work (SOW) describes the work to accomplish this.

- Diagnosis and repair required to ensure the NexLog 740 is functioning free of fault must be completed on-site during installation.
- Training must be conducted for both technical and operator staff at the OCC.
   Technical training must provide RCMP technicians the knowledge and skills to diagnosis and repair faults with the equipment. The operator training must provide RCMP operators with the knowledge and skills to effectively use the equipment and the various software interfaces.
- The training must train qty 8 operators and qty 4 technicians. The 4 technicians must also receive the operator training.
- All work must be performed between Monday and Friday (0800 -1600 hrs) at the RCMP OCC located in Yellowknife, Northwest Territories.
