

1. <u>Please insert:</u>

The document "FP802-160421_Maintenance dredging using ground equipments, Gaspé Peninsula, QC_Drawings Before dredging sounding" (5 pages).

This document consists of high resolution of the drawings (before dredging sounding) for the five (5) areas.



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THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS WAS SUBMITTED BY A POTENTIAL BIDDER TO THE CONTRACTING AUTHORITY IN RELATION TO THE SUBJECT ITT:

Question 11 from bidder:

The areas of dredging indicated on the plans are not clear. Can we have distances, lateral limits in meters, dredging depths and clear areas to evaluate the project?

MPO answer 11:

Please refer to the document added via this Addendum no. 3.

Question 12 from bidder:

If the Contractor provides dredging equipment that can reach a range as shown on the sketch (dimensions in feet) Section 01 11 11, and the dredging area is not 100% reachable, do we make a path to reach the lateral limit of the dredging areas?

MPO answer 12:

No.

Question 13 from bidder:

Do you have materials available for building a path to do the work request?

MPO answer 13:

No

Question 14 from bidder:

In section 35 20 23 of the estimate, you mention on page 2 of 17 an installation of containment curtains. Are you going to require this curtain if there is an ice cover in areas or near areas to be dredged?

MPO answer 14:


In the event of a fixed ice cover, the containment curtain will be required. In the case of drifting ice and / or strong currents, the containment curtain will not be required.

Question 15 from bidder:

In Addendum 1, you answer question 2 by telling bidders to comply with municipal by-laws, which must comply with the requirements of the Province of Quebec. Do we understand that you will require a scrap site with an environmental CA?

MPO answer 15:

Generally, municipalities must obtain an authorization from the province before authorizing the deposit of materials. The provincial document authorizing the municipality to receive the materials must be provided to us.



Question 16 from bidder:

With regard to the settlement tank for dredged materials, can we use standard geotextile membrane type 3-4 in the bottom of the basin or a waterproof membrane?

MPO answer 16:

Yes

Question 17 from bidder:

Should we install a waterproof canvas on top of piles of dredged material during the settling period or is not necessary?

MPO answer 17:

If dredged materials remain in place for less than 24 hours, waterproof fabric will not be required.

Question 18 from bidder:

Is it possible to have copies of plans with better resolution, the copies of plans in the quotation is illegible (see a copy in appendix), it is essential to be able to read the information on the plans, we are not even able to see the depth of the seabed, area etc...

MPO answer 18:


Question 19 from bidder:
