
This amendment is being raised to respond to questions submitted in response to solicitation 5P420-16-5403/A:

A. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1. The below owner furnished items are listed "as available to the contractor". Are the below items free (zero cost) to the contractor? Would the contractor have to make arrangements with Parks Canada to pick them up? Is there someone at the pickup site to help the contractor to load? Or would the contractor be responsible to load the truck as well?

1.10 OWNER FURNISHED ITEMS

- .1 The following materials are stored in Cascade Pit and will be available to the Contractor:
 - .1 9,000 x 3.7 m pressure treated wood fence posts (unsharpened)
 - .2 2,000 x 4.2 m pressure treated wood fence posts (unsharpened)
 - .3 1,300 x 3.7 m steel fence posts c/w sleeves and caps
 - .4 24,000 m of graduated wildlife fencing mesh
 - .5 24,000 m of 6 mm (7x19) galvanized top wire
 - .6 14,500 m of 1.2 m chainlink anti-predator apron
 - .7 5 x pedestrian gates c/w stairs
 - .8 Fencing brace systems:
 - .1 500 x 2440 mm (8') steel tubing with pre-drilled holes
 - .2 820 x 610 mm (24") adjustable sleeve with pre-drilled holes
 - .3 210 x 305 mm (12") adjustable sleeve with pre-drilled holes
 - .4 Installation hardware including mounting brackets, 12.5 mm flat washers, 12.5 mm lock washers, 12.5 mm nuts, 88.9 mm bolts and 50.8 mm bolts. 12.5 mm threaded rods not included.
- .2 The quantities specified under "Unit Price Item 1 Supply of Wildlife Fencing Materials" shall not be considered as being reduced by the above quantities.
- A1. See Section 01 11 00 Summary of Work, Part 1.10 & Section 32 31 26 Wildlife Exclusion Fencing: Owner-supplied materials are free for the Contractor's use. The Owner-supplied materials are located in Cascade Pit which is central to the Project Location (access from Banff Avenue/TCH interchange at TCH km 13, with TCH km 0 at the Banff East Park Gate). Refer to Drawing sheet C02 for location of Cascade Pit. The Contractor will be responsible for handling all Owner-supplied materials to complete the work including loading, hauling and delivering to work areas. The quantity of Contractor-supplied materials under Unit Price Item 1 shall not be reduced by the quantities of Owner-supplied materials.
- Q2. Can you please confirm the height of owner supplied 24000m of graduated wildlife fence?
- A2. The Owner-supplied Graduated Wildlife Fencing Mesh is approximately 2.5m (96 inches) high, packaged and stockpiled in 100m (330 feet) long rolls. See Section 32 31 26 Wildlife Exclusion Fencing.
- Q3. Is there a designated site for disposal of existing fence?
- A3. All removed existing fence and fencing components must be removed from the National Parks. It is the Contractor's responsibility to arrange for disposal of the materials. See Section 32 31 26 Wildlife Exclusion Fencing.





- Q4. Does existing fence have predator chain link apron and does it have to be removed?
- A4. The existing fence is an older-style construction with no buried predator apron. Over the years, some short sections of this fence may have been retrofitted with buried predator apron. If any sections of the existing fence have buried predator apron, the apron must be removed and disposed of outside of the National Parks at the Contractor's cost.
- Q5. Is there an estimated quantity of brushing and clearing of fence right of way that needs to be done?
- A5. Brushing and clearing has been completed recently under separate contracts. If site conditions call for brushing or clearing to accommodate the new fence, work methods shall be in accordance with all Contract Documents and will be determined with the Departmental Representative and Environmental Surveillance Officer.
- Q6. Is there any specs on brushing and clearing ie... row width, distance from fence, height...?
- A6. Brushing and clearing has been completed recently under separate contracts. If site conditions call for brushing or clearing to accommodate the new fence, work methods shall be in accordance with all Contract Documents and will be determined with the Departmental Representative and Environmental Surveillance Officer.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
