Q2. Will the Crown extends the ITQ by 1 month – making the new date April 28th, and updating the question period to be valid until April 21st.	As mentioned in the Notice of Proposed Procurement, this ITQ is a re-issue of the same ITQ posted on buyandsell.gc.ca from January 10 to February 9th, 2017. In addition, this ITQ remains unchanged from the original version posted previously. As a result, an extension of 1 month will not be granted. However, Canada will agree to extend to April 4, 2017. Questions and answer period will be extended until March 29, 2017.

Will SSC accept Generic project details that do not reference the client by name or details on the client's program support.	No. In order to qualify for the ITQ, Respondents must demonstrate their experience using specific detailed examples of the projects and/or worked performed. Not providing an organization name and contact details would deem the Respondant non-compliant as Canada would not be able to validate the project reference information provided.
Q5. Can SSC please describe a way in which we can provide a compliant bid without using customer information or reference details as the client is not able to provide references.	No. Canada cannot provide this information. Given the structure and intent of the ITQ process, there would be no way for Canada to evaluate the ITQ response without specific detailed examples of the projects and/or work performed; as well as reference contact information.
